The movement features Habring's flying one-minute tourbillon. The eight tentacles represent the eight pieces made.

This 50mm x 42mm x 17.8mm timepiece is made of black PVD titanium. Its self-winding mechanical movement, made in-house, features hours, retrograde minutes and power reserve. The dial has red highlights, and the piece is presented on a brown and black hand-sewn Louisiana alligator leather strap.

This 41mm round timepiece, with steel stirrup, is inspired by the equestrian world. This skeleton's two sapphire crystals reveal the beating heart of the mechanism within.
